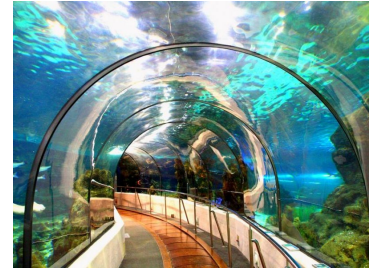


2014 Western Mediterranean Aquarium Cruise Itinerary with Tom and Aletha Lang

Saturday, May 17th - 10am - Tour the **Aquarium Barcelona** (Catalan: Aquàrium de Barcelona) The Aquarium is located in Port Vell, the cruise terminal in Barcelona, Spain. The 35 aquariums at the facility are home to 11,000 animals representing 450 species, and an 80-meter (260 ft) underwater tunnel.



Sunday, May 18th - 12pm - Royal Caribbean's *Liberty of the Seas*



Monday, May 19th - 9am - 6pm Provence (Marseilles), France
The Mare Nostrum (Latin for "Our Sea") Aquarium is located in the city of Montpellier, about an hour south of Marseilles. It was opened on December 15, 2007 and an expansion was opened in April 2011.

Tuesday, May 20th - 7am - 7pm Villefranche (Nice), France
Monaco Aquarium (Musée océanographique de Monaco) - Built on the side of the legendary rock of Monaco, the Oceanographic Museum has watched over the Mediterranean for over a century. Created by Prince Albert the 1st in 1906, the Aquarium

today features more than 6,000 species, including thousands of fish, 200+ species of invertebrates and a hundred species of hard and soft corals. This is where Dr. Jean Jaubert developed what is known today as the Jaubert Method - a means of de-nitrification in coral reef aquariums. We'll see the Shark Lagoon, Turtle Island, the panoramic terrace and all the unique opportunities this museum has to offer.



Wednesday, May 21st - 7am - 7pm La Spezia (Florence/Pisa), Italy Explore the Uffizi Gallery in Florence, home to works by Leonardo Da Vinci, Michelangelo, Raphael and Rubens.

Thursday, May 22nd - 7am - 7pm Civitavecchia (Rome), Italy - Visit Vatican City, St. Peter's.

Friday, May 23rd - 7am - 6:30pm Naples (Capri), Italy - Explore Naples and visit Pompeii.
